###### Cartoon Drawing

Subjects for Cartoon drawing will be announced just prior to commencement of the event.

###### Clay Modeling

Subjects for Clay Modeling will be announced just prior to commencement of the event.

For Clay Modeling Competition:

- Clay required for the modeling work & its display base will be provided by BKS.
- Only a finite amount of clay will be provided with which the participant shall make the model.
- Painting on the model and use of any tools or moulds will not be allowed.
- For reinforcement purposes, toothpicks can be used. No other objects will be permitted for this purpose.

###### Painting

- Subjects for Painting will be announced just prior to commencement of the event.
- For the Painting competition, the participants can use any type of coloring medium.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For the Painting competition for <b>Group 1 the participant</b> shall be provided with a template to paint.</li> </ul>
<b>Pencil Drawing</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Subjects for Pencil Drawing will be announced just prior to commencement of the event.</li> <li>For Pencil drawing competition, participants shall use only lead pencil.</li> </ul>
<b>Poster Designing</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Subjects for Poster Design will be announced just prior to commencement of the event.</li> <li>For Poster design, the competition will be conducted on the spot and the participants will be requested to do poster making on the subject / topic / theme given.</li> <li>Participants shall bring their own material.</li> <li>For Poster design competition, the participants can use any type of coloring medium.</li> </ul>
<b>Vegetable Carving</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For Vegetable Carving:</li> <li>Participants have to bring the required Fruits, Vegetable, Carving objects, Tools and Base plate for the competition.</li> <li>No pre-carved objects will be allowed.</li> <li>Only toothpicks can be used for reinforcement.</li> </ul>

<b>Bharatanatyam</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For Bharatanatyam Group 3, participants are expected to perform a <b>“Padam or Keerthanam”</b> only.</li> <li>For Bharatanatyam Group 4 and 5 participants are expected to perform a <b>“Varnam”</b>.</li> <li>All audio files for the competition should be submitted in USB flash drives in mp3 format <b>without any other contents other than concerned files.</b></li> </ul>
<b>Cinematic Dance</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For Cinematic Dance (both individual &amp; team) only Indian Film Music from any Indian Language with appropriate costume shall be permitted.</li> <li>Decency and decorum shall be maintained in the dress and steps performed.</li> <li>Classical as well as Western dance steps will not have any added advantage for judgment.</li> <li>Simple Stage setting is permitted. Props if any should be cleared from the stage immediately after the performance.</li> <li>Only one person will be allowed (Maximum 2 minutes) with the contestant for assistance backstage.</li> <li>All audio files for the competition should be submitted in USB flash drive in mp3 format <b>without any other contents other than concerned files.</b></li> </ul>
<b>Folk Dance</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For Folk Dance (for both individual and team) Competition, film songs shall not be used.</li> <li>Folk Dance should be with a theme / story with expression and rhythm.</li> <li>Decency and decorum shall be maintained in the dress and steps performed.</li> <li>No Stage setting is permitted.</li> <li>Hand props if any should be cleared from the stage immediately after the performance.</li> <li>Only one person will be allowed (Maximum 2 minutes) with the contestant for assistance backstage.</li> <li>All audio files for the competition should be submitted in USB flash drives in mp3 format <b>without any other contents other than concerned files.</b></li> </ul>

<b>Essay Writing (English)</b> Subjects for Events Essay Writing will be announced just before the commencement of the event
<b>Poem Writing English</b> Subjects for Poem Writing will be announced just before the commencement of the event <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>For poem writing in order to discourage writing down previously memorized script, incomplete segments of scripts written by renowned writers will be issued to the participants. The Participant shall complete the script using their imagination and skills.</li></ul>
<b>Short Story writing English</b> Subjects for Short Story Writing will be announced just before the commencement of the event. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>For short story writing, in order to discourage writing down previously memorized script, incomplete segments of scripts (clue words) will be issued to the participants. The Participant shall complete the script using their imagination and skills.</li></ul>
<b>Speech English, Hindi, Malayalam</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>For the Speech (English &amp; Malayalam) contests, the subject will be provided 10 minutes prior to the commencement of the event.</li></ul>
<b>Story Telling English, Malayalam</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Please see the judgment criteria</li></ul>
<b>Poem Recitation- English/Hindi/Malayalam</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>For poem recitation, the introduction about the author and poem should be brief.</li><li>Too much action and melody is not expected from the participants.</li></ul>
<b>Action Song</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>For Action Song, the participant can sing in any of the Indian languages or English.</li><li>Creativity is encouraged. Nevertheless, movements should not exceed and overwhelm the articulation of the song by the contestants.</li><li>Props should be minimal.</li><li>Participants can wear appropriate costumes in line with the characters they portray.</li><li>Use of recorded music is not allowed.</li></ul>

<p><b>Classical Music – Carnatic</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For Classical Music competition, the participant has to bring their own 'Shruthi boxes'</li> <li>No other background music or instrumental accompaniment is permitted.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Classical Music – Hindustani</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For Hindustani Music competition, the participant may use 'Shruthi Boxes'.</li> <li>No other background music or instrumental accompaniment is permitted.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Film Song Hindi</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For Film song Hindi, the song shall have to be in Hindi and from Hindi films. No orchestra support is permitted.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Film Song Malayalam</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For the Malayalam Film Song competition, songs have to be from Malayalam Films and in Malayalam Language. No orchestra support is permitted.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Instrumental Music Percussion/Wind &amp; String</b></p> <p>For Instrumental Music, the instruments should be brought by participants themselves. In the Western Instruments only western numbers are to be played. For Stringed - Western 'delay unit' should not be used</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For instrumental music (both individual &amp; team), no electronic instruments with pre-recorded facility shall be used.</li> <li>The use of pre-set tones on the keyboard is permitted. Such instruments will be subjected to the inspection and approval of the competent authority appointed by the Executive Committee.</li> <li>The name of the instrument shall be entered in the Entry form.</li> </ul>

#### 3.1.5.1 Rules and Regulations for Special Events

##### Fancy Dress

- Moderate verbal expressions are allowed subject to the relevance of the character.
- No pre-recorded sound, effects (light / sound) are allowed.
- No stage settings are allowed.

##### General Knowledge

- General Knowledge test for Group-I will be oral. The majority of the questions will be about the GCC countries and India.
- In addition to the above topics, Group 2 questions may include GCC countries, expansion of abbreviations, inventors, geographical facts and personalities in world politics.
- Group 3, 4 & 5 contestants should be aware of all the above topics. Questions can be expected from literature, science, sports, current affairs and the world around us. The level of the test will be matching the age of contestants.

##### Intelligence Test

- Intelligence test, Group-I will also be oral. Simple arithmetic, easy puzzles and visual comprehension will be tested. For all the other groups, general aptitude, logical reasoning, puzzles etc. will be tested.

**Memory Test**

- Memory test will be conducted by displaying various items to the participants and asking the participants to name the items.
- In case of tie in result, a tie breaker test is conducted.

**Mimicry**

- Mimicry -Insults and defamatory remarks should be avoided

**Mono Act**

- For Mono Act, the participant presents a theme involving variety of expressions and characters.
- Mimicking will not be accorded any advantage.
- The participants may use English, Malayalam or Hindi as the language for expressing their theme.

Props if any should be cleared from the stage immediately after the performance.</li> <li>Only one person will be allowed (Maximum 2 minutes) with the contestant for assistance backstage.</li> <li>All audio files for the competition should be submitted in USB flash drives in mp3 format <b>without any other contents other than concerned files.</b></li> </ul>
<b>Folk Dance</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For Folk Dance (for both individual and team) Competition, film songs shall not be used.</li> <li>Folk Dance should be with a theme / story with expression and rhythm.</li> <li>Decency and decorum shall be maintained in the dress and steps performed.</li> <li>No Stage setting is permitted. - b. Won at least one A grade
- c. Won prizes from at least three individual categories of events.
- d. Participation in any Team Event

From a particular individual event category, only top 5 results will be considered for the award

### **6.2 KALAPRATHIBHA**

Ever rolling trophy with certificate will be presented to the Boy participant who scores the highest point in Group 3, 4 and 5 and meet the following criteria:

- a. Won at least one first prize
- b. Won at least one A grade
- c. Won prizes from at least three individual categories of events.
- d. Participation in any Team Event

From a particular individual event category, only top 5 results will be considered for the award

### **6.3 BALATHILAKAM**

Ever rolling trophy with certificate will be presented to the Girl participant who scores the highest point in Group 1 and 2 and meet the following criteria:

- a. Won at least one first prize
- b. Won at least one A grade
- c. Won prizes from at least three individual categories of events.
- d. Participation in any Team Event

From a particular individual event category, only top 5 results will be considered for the award

### **6.4 BALAPRATHIBHA**

Ever rolling trophy with certificate will be presented to the Boy participant who scores the highest point in Group 1 and 2 and meet the following criteria:

- a. Won at least one first prize
- b. Won at least one A grade
- c. Won prizes from at least three individual categories of events.
- d. Participation in any Team Event

From a particular individual event category, only top 5 results will be considered for the award

## **6.5 Championship Awards**

### **Group Championship**



The participant (Boy or Girl), attaining the overall highest points in each Age Group with minimum one First prize an A Grade and won prizes from minimum 3 individual categories of events will be presented with Group Championship Award. He/She must participate in at least one of the team events.

## 6.6 Special Group Championship

The participant (Boy or Girl) attaining the highest points with minimum one prize and an A Grade in each Age Group among BKS children, will be presented a separate BKS Group Championship award. This will be awarded only if the Group championship is not won by a child of a BKS member. He/she must participate in any of the team events. (He/she must be registered as a BKS member at the time of the registration)

## 6.7 Special GCC Junior Championship

The participant (Boy or Girl) attaining the highest points with minimum one prize and an A Grade in Age Groups 1 & 2 among Non-Bahrain residents, will be presented a Special GCC Championship award. **This will be awarded only if the child hasn't won any of the other title awards.**

## 6.8 Special GCC Senior Championship

The participant (Boy or Girl) attaining the highest points with minimum one prize and an A Grade in Age Groups 3,4 & 5 among Non-Bahrain residents, will be presented a Special GCC Championship award. **This will be awarded only if the child hasn't won any of the other title awards.**

## 6.9 Natya Ratna

The participant (Boy or Girl), attaining the overall highest points among all Age Groups in the category "dance events", with minimum one First prize and an A Grade will be presented with Natya Ratna award. He/she must also participate in team events.

## 6.10 Sangeeta Ratna

The participant (Boy or Girl), attaining the overall highest points among all Age Groups in the category "music events", with minimum one First prize and an A Grade will be presented with Sangeeta Ratna award. He/she must also participate in team events.

## 6.11 Sahitya Ratna

The participant (Boy or Girl), attaining the overall highest points among all Age Groups in the category "literary event", with minimum one First prize and an A Grade will be presented with Sahitya Ratna Award.

## 6.12 Kala Ratna

The participant (Boy or Girl), attaining the overall highest points among all Age Groups in the category "Art Event" with minimum one First prize and an A Grade will be presented with Kala Ratna Award. He/she must also participate in team events.

### Note:

- Rank points & Grade points of events will be added together to determine the highest points in all the above cases.
- In case of a tie for the above awards, the participant who secured maximum First prizes will be considered as the award winner.
- If the tie still persists, the participant who secured the maximum A grades will be selected as the award winner.
- If the tie still persists, the participant who secured maximum Second prizes will be considered as the award winner.

- If the tie still persists, the participant who secured the maximum B grades will be selected as the award winner.
- If the tie still persists, the participant who secured maximum Third prizes will be considered as the award winner.
- If the tie still persists, the participant who secured the maximum C grades will be selected as the award winner.
- If the tie still persists the participants will be declared as joint award winners.
- In the case that the Kalathilakam or Kalaprathibha also happens to be eligible for the Group Championship award, the next applicable participant in the same group, who meets the criteria, will be presented the group championship award.
- Team events' points are not considered for any individual awards.

7. For all the events, judges' decisions shall be final and binding. No discussions or complaints shall be entertained. Contestants or parents, relatives shall not contact judges before or after the event. Such conduct shall result in disqualification of the participant for the current or upcoming events(s).
8. **The decision of the Executive Committee or any other body appointed by them shall be final and binding on all concerned.**
9. The Executive committee reserves the right to publish the details or results of GCC Kalotsavam in the media.  
*Individuals/parents/Relatives/Participants/Viewers shall stay away from publishing/criticising/ alleging the judgment /results in Medias. Any such attempts/acts will be considered as the violation of rules.*
10. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against any BKS member, Parent or Participant who violates the rules, regulations & indulges in any form of communication/queries/arguments with regard to the results/judges/scoring etc.
11. For individual events certificates and trophies will be awarded to First, Second and third prize winners. For team events trophies will be awarded to First, Second and third prize winners and certificates to all the winning participants.
12. First, Second and Third places will have a valuation of Five, Three and One point(s) respectively.  
The performance of each participant for each event will be graded as A, B or C as follows

3. Order of stage appearance shall be decided by lot, which will be taken 10 minutes before the commencement of each stage event.
4. Participants must strictly adhere to the reporting time. Any participant reporting late after the allotment of the performing order will strictly NOT be allowed to participate in that stage event. Any communication in this regard, prior to the commencement of the event, will not be entertained.
5. Participants must adhere to the time limit specified for each event. Participants exceeding the time limit will be disqualified.
6. No special light or sound effects shall be allowed in the competition, except where permitted.
7. Personal video/photography will be STRICTLY NOT ALLOWED during the competitions. For selected events a videography facility is arranged. Participants can avail this facility by registering prior to the event. BD 5 will be charged for individual events and BD 10 for group events. Request from minimum 5 participants is required to avail this facility.
8. Persons other than participants and officials will not be allowed backstage nor in and around the scoring & results room during the competition.
9. Use of fire, flammables shall not be permitted during performances.
10. Parents should ensure the safety of children during performances and practice sessions avoiding dangerous steps which may cause injury to the participants or co-participants.
11. No leftovers of props, ornaments to be on the stage after the performance. Everything should be cleared in a given time after the performance.
12. An initial list of eligible participants will be displayed on the Samajam notice board, BKS website ([www.bksbahrain.com](http://www.bksbahrain.com)) and WhatsApp group after scrutiny. Contestants or their parents are to verify this list and bring to the notice of the Samajam, any errors and/or omissions in this list within the given time .
13. The GCC KALOTSAVAM is meant for children of Indian origin and other nationalities (*other nationalities for Team Event*) residing and studying in GULF COOPERATION COUNCIL (GCC). The Participant shall be a student of any recognized schools in GCC. Participants not meeting this criterion shall not be allowed to compete, even if their resident permit/Visa/NATIONAL ID are found valid for a legal stay in GCC.
14. Accommodation for the Participants and parents from outside Bahrain will be provided for dance & music events for participating days. Transportation from accommodation to venue will be arranged by BKS. All other expenses Visa, ticket etc. shall be borne by contestant themselves
15. The Programme schedule will be displayed on the Samajam notice board and BKS website ([www.bksbahrain.com](http://www.bksbahrain.com)).
16. The tentative date of commencement of literary and other non-stage events shall be on 1st week of April 2024.
17. Parents & Participants may visit the BKS website [www.bksbahrain.com](http://www.bksbahrain.com) for up to date details on the GCC Kalotsavam 2024. Also, a whatsapp group will be created for each age group for sharing updates.
